This will involve dividing tasks up between them and making decisions about what they will have within the rainforest. • Children to use large leaves to create their own design and prints. • Children to design and build shelters. <p>LC1 - How can you create your own class rainforest? LC6 - Can you create a print using the large leaves of rainforest plants as your inspiration? LC7 - How would you survive in the rainforest?</p>
