<p>English Link</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide opportunities for children to research some of Europe’s famous cities and the relationship they have with rivers. • Requires children to use the internet to find out about a European city. <p>LS1 - What are the common features you notice when locating all of Europe’s/Britain’s biggest cities?</p> <p>LS 3 - Can you choose a major European city and create a brochure to encourage someone to visit?</p>
<p>Maths Link</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There could be opportunities taken to find out about the length of many of Europe’s rivers and then create data packages, etc. • Looking at how the London underground works could provide some interesting work around geometry.
<p>Creative Art Link</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Get children to design and make a tall building so that they appreciate the issues surrounding building some of the skyscrapers in our cities.
