Geography/ History Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • KS2 Geography: understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of human and physical geography of a region or area in a European country. • KS2 History: A study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.
English Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opportunities for children to find out information about one of the Greek Gods. • Opportunities for children to debate issues and to understand more about democracy. • Provide children with opportunities to research the main tourist attractions in Greece • Opportunities for children to create a Greek myth • Children to write their own Greek Myth play script
Maths Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opportunities for children to carry out surveys and to present information in data and statistical forms.
Creative Art Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The children should research how the Greeks made clay pots and use techniques such as coiling to make their own and decorate them accordingly.
Expressive Art Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Act out the Greek myths and create a song using instruments
Computing Link	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opportunities for children to research Greece's tourist attractions and to locate Greece on a world map

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
