<p>Geography/ History Link</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The achievements of the earliest civilizations – an overview of the impact the Ancient Egyptians had on our society
<p>English Link</p>	<p>Children to think of the questions they would wish to ask an Ancient Egyptian, if they met one. Opportunities for research about Egypt – its geographical location and its history. Opportunities for distinctive research on the Pharaohs, about individual pharaohs and how they were regarded. Children do discuss what they would leave in a time capsule if they wanted someone to make sense of our way of life in 2000 years' time.</p>

<p>Creative Art Link</p>	<p>Children will design and make their own Pyramids which will contain at least one hidden compartment.</p>
<p>Expressive Art Link</p>	<p>Children have to find out about Egyptian dances and then perform them as a group.</p>
<p>Computing Link</p>	<p>Children will take photographs to help them work out what would have been here 50, 100 or even 250 years ago</p>
