There are an increasing number of children wearing Smart Watches in school and we are, therefore, experiencing an increasing number of safeguarding and privacy concerns because of this. They are also an added distraction to the children during lessons and it is very difficult to monitor that they are used appropriately at break times. Please could children not wear any Smart Watches to school, although analogue and digital watches that simply tell the time are still permitted. Thank you for your support .

Please could you ensure that all children who bring a packed lunch to school, do so in a named lunch box or container and not in plastic carrier bags. Could we also remind parents and carers that we have an increasing number of pupils and



adults who have nut allergies and, therefore, strive to be a 'Nut Free' school.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation with this matter.

Please could parents and carers of KS1 children sensure that they are brought into, and collected from, inside the school grounds (KS1 playground) at the start and end of the school day.

Please could KS2 pupils not arrive before 8:40am. We ask the children to return inside school if there is no-one to pick them up at the end of the day and that they do not leave school with friends and neighbours unless it has been agreed and arranged. Although this may be done with good intentions, doing so can cause undue concern and worry if children are not at school as expected at collection time. Please contact school if there is any delay at the end of the day. Thank you.

We welcome Mr Edward Jip as the Year 3 teacher for the Summer term, whilst the recruitment process takes place for our new Deputy Head Teacher. We hope to successfully recruit a new appointment for September 2024.

We are recruiting a new Site Manager for an appointment as soon as possible. This would be for 25 hours per week. We are also seeking to appoint a Teaching Assistant Level 2 for 28.5 hours per week as soon as possible.

WOW is a pupil-led initiative where children self-report how they get to school every day using an interactive WOW Travel Tracker. If they travel sustainably (walk/wheel, cycle or scoot) once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge (see below). It's that easy!
