As many parents will be aware, Mr Jackson returned to school after a long term absence at Easter.

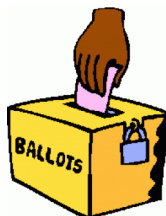
Unfortunately, his recovery has not gone according to plan and he has, with much regret, taken the decision to tender his resignation. He will leave us at the end of July.

Yet again we have to mention dropping off children before school. Our PCSOs have asked that we send out reminder letters to those who need reminding that research indicates that seems only 17% of people know stopping on **zig-zags** is banned at school-run times. While it may be well known that you can't park on yellow zig-zag lines, **you also can't wait or even stop momentarily to drop off or pick up passengers, according to the UK Highway Code, which states:-**

Rule 238 (a section from)



Keep entrance clear of stationary vehicles, even if picking up or setting down children

You **MUST NOT** wait or park, or stop to set down and pick up passengers, on school entrance markings ... when upright signs indicate a prohibition of stopping.
