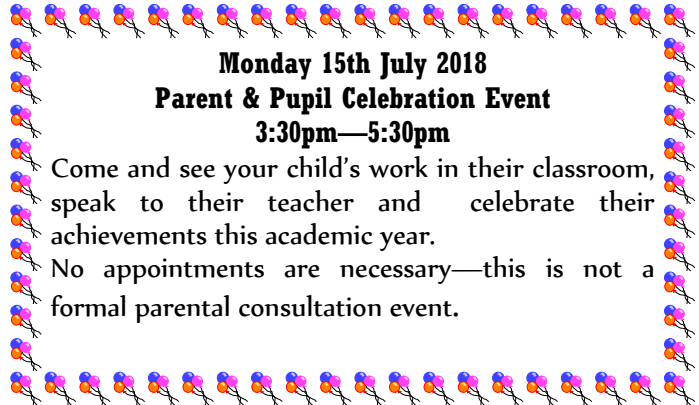

Come and see your child's work in their classroom, speak to their teacher and celebrate their achievements this academic year. No appointments are necessary—this is not a formal parental consultation event.



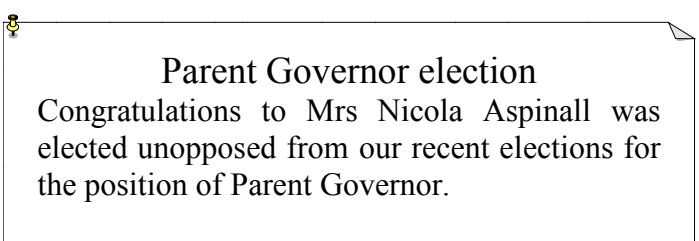
