Re: Year 3 and 4 trip to Wales and Year 6 trip to Robinwood

We're sure that you have been wondering about the arrangements for the two residential trips that were planned for the summer term.

We are still eager for these to take place so we have just had confirmation about the options available to us.

Year 3 and 4 – Naturesbase, Wales

We have been offered Monday 9th to Wednesday 11th November 2020 as an alternative date. We realise that the children will be in their next year group but their experiences are not age related and hopefully fill some of the gaps in their learning from the lockdown period; their schedule would be the same - as would, we believe, their enjoyment of the learning at the site. We first went to Naturesbase around these dates and had a great time.

Year 6 - Robinwood

We have again been able to re-arrange the date but the venue will now be their (newest) site in Wrexham. We have pencilled in Friday 10th to Sunday 12th July. This is the last weekend before what would have been the school closure date for the summer break of 17th July but it would be a great way to draw to a close their time at St Andrew's. It is as late as we could arrange in the hope that we would be back to school by then. This trip is still very much dependent on the COVID 19 lockdown of venues directives.
