Out of School Tax Free Child Care

If you or your partner both work and earn between minimum wage and £100,000 per year, you are probably eligible to **save 25%** on Child-care costs with HMRC Tax Free Childcare.

It is very easy to apply and school have already registered. Each month you add funds to your HMRC account and **for every £8 you pay, they give you a £2 top up.** Payments are then made direct to school by HMRC.

It is quick and easy to upload the voucher to school Spider, and then book in to sessions in exactly the same way as we have always done but instead of paying by card, you use your voucher credit. You can cancel sessions for a refund back to your voucher or make changes up to 24 hours prior to the session just like paying by card.
